**Evaluation Methods Used:** The main testing tools and methods used were manual keyboard evaluation, WAVE (Web Accessibility Evaluation Tool) browser plugin from WebAIM, Colour Contrast Analyser (CCA), the IBM Equal Access Accessibility Checker, ARC Toolkit, JAWS (Job Access With Speech) screen reader from Freedom Scientific, NVDA screen reader, and Apple iPad for mobile testing. The browsers used were Google Chrome and Microsoft Edge.

Infobase is committed to expanding audio description support going forward by prioritizing our most popular titles and customer requests to receive audio descriptions.
